It was a very constructive discussion listening to everyone's opinions together with ideas and suggestions put forward for the parish council to consider such as:

- dog fouling awareness campaign
- dog law seminar session to understand legal rights of dog owners
- identifying areas of land within the parish close to the Cricket Ground ie unused allotment land and land to the rear of the medical centre for use as a dog paddock/area to exercise dogs
- cameras on the cricket club pavilion
- fencing around play area
- dogs on leads during the cricket season and off leads off season
- engagement of local dog warden

The decision made by the Parish Council under the council's standing orders remains for six months from the date it was minuted but the feedback received provides the parish council the opportunity to review the suggestions in the interim.
