

Report for the Parish Council AGM - 07/05/2025

Good Evening.

The committee of the Community Centre at Studley Green is chaired by myself, Sue Wilkins, and has a further nine members and six trustees.

CCSG is a registered charity who rely heavily on income generated by our regular hirers, grants and donations. Unfortunately, during the last year we have lost our Toddler Group and Youth Club due to not being able to find someone new to run them. We have also lost Radfield Home Care, who offered daycare one day a week. This means that we have lost some regular income in the last year. Occasional Hirings have also decreased since SPC's last AGM.

The current regular users of the hall include: a monthly coffee morning, brass band practise, High Wycombe Model plane club, several art groups, Woollywonkas crochet club, the A.A., Christian Fellowship, yoga, the 7th Day Adventists, Dance Fitness, HITT, Step Aerobics, Barre Fitness and the Rockhopper Morris Dancers. We are very grateful for their support and we hope to continue to work closely with them to maintain a good working relationship.

We continue to reinvest every penny we raise maintaining and improving the centre for current and future hirers and the community. In the last year we have replaced the flooring and painted the entrance way. All five radiators in the main hall have been replaced, the walls have been painted and the floor deeply cleaned and re varnished. The bar room has received a face lift and now looks warm, cosy and inviting. Our meeting room has also had a new coat of paint. Lastly, the entrance and exit barriers for the car park have had a refresh.

We have a few small projects planned for the coming year, the first being the replacement of the oven in the kitchen and the second is purchasing a new carpet for the meeting room. We may also need to replace the oil tank, but this will be expensive.
