Knitted Poppy Royal British Legion Pattern

Step 1: Body of poppy

- Using Red DK yarn and 3.5/3.75 needles cast on 60 sts.
- Rows 1-10 K2, P2 across whole row (for a slightly smaller poppy do 8 rows of rib).
- Row 11 - K2tog across the row (30 sts).
- Row 12 – sl 1, k2tog, pssso Repeat across the row (10 sts).
- Break off yarn with a long tail and thread back through remaining sts, pull tight. Join edges with mattress stitch.



Step 2: Centre of poppy

- Use a black button and sew to centre of poppy. OR
- Using black yarn cast on 16 sts. Cast off.
- Coil into a tight spiral and sew to the centre of poppy.

Crochet Polly Royal British Legion Pattern

- Chain 3 using red yarn and 3.0/3.5mm hook
- Insert hook into 2nd chain and pull through, repeat for 3rd into base stitch (4 sts on hook).
- Yarn over and pull through 2 loops, repeat until there is 1 on your hook, chain 1.
- Pull yarn through 1st and 2nd loop on the front (3 sts on hook), pull through on loop at base stitch (4 sts on hook) and again into the next chain in magic circle (5 sts on hook).
- Yarn over and pull through 2, repeat until you have 1 stitch left on your hook, chain 1.
- Pull yarn through 1st, 2nd, and 3rd loop on the front (4 sts on hook), pull through in the next chain in the circle (5 sts on hook).
- Yarn over and pull through 2, repeat until have 1 stitch left on your hook, chain 1.
- Repeat the last 2 steps 5 times.
- Slip stitch the 1st loop on the front, then slip stitch the 2nd and 3rd, loop together.
- Slip stitch into your 1st stitch of the circle and finish off.

Felt Poppy Pattern

- Cut 4 to 6 petals in red felt
- Join at the base with hot glue or sew running stitches across all the bases and pull tight.
- Use a black button or black felt to make small circle and hot glue or sew to the centre of the poppy.
