Election of One Parish Councillor to Stokenchurch ward of Stokenchurch Parish Council

1. Forms for nomination may be obtained at The Gateway, Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury, HP19 8FF from a Deputy Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature. 2. Nomination papers must be hand delivered to a Deputy Returning Officer at The Gateway, Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury, HP19 8FF between 10am and 4pm on the following dates only:
 - Thursday 24 September 2026
 - Friday 25 September 2026
 - Monday 28 September 2026
 - Tuesday 29 September 2026
 - Wednesday 30 September 2026
 - Thursday 1 October 2026
 - Friday 2 October 2026

Nomination papers must be hand delivered no later than 4pm on Friday 2 October 2026.

3. If the vacancy is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 29 October 2026.
4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 13 October 2026. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Gateway, Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury, HP19 8FF by 5 pm on Wednesday 14 October 2026. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote
6. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Gateway, Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury, HP19 8FF by 5pm on Wednesday 21 October 2026. 7. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Gateway, Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury, HP19 8FF by 5pm on Wednesday 21 October 2026. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
8. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at The Gateway, Gatehouse Road, Aylesbury, HP19 8FF by 5pm on Thursday 29 October 2026. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 21 October 2026. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 21 October 2026.
